## Histopathology Report

Clinical notes: 'Punch bx lesion R pinna - ?SCC'.

### Macroscopic Appearance:

'R ear'. A 3 mm disc of skin with tissue 4 mm in depth bearing a grey surface. 1-1/AE.

### Microscopic Appearance:

Sections show an ulcerated basaloid lesion comprising solid nests of basaloid cells undergoing abrupt trichilemmal type keratinisation.

Ghost cells and foreign body type multinucleated giant cells are seen.

Stromal haemorrhage and fibrosis is noted. There is no evidence of malignancy. Overall the appearances are consistent with pilomatrixoma.

### Summary:

Skin, R ear - CONSISTENT WITH PILOMATRIXOMA.
